Pregnancy and Relationship Education serving seven counties in Southwest Missouri.

LIVES ENRICHED IN 2008:

- Provided pregnancy and relationship programs serving over 23,447 young people.
- Delivered services to over 1,496 new clients reaching 5,818 total client contacts.
- Mentored 952 clients for more than 13 months.
- Equipped over 140 fathers to build stable families.
- Empowered students to choose healthy relationships reaching 21,951 total student contacts.
- Reported teen pregnancies declining more than 20%, double the national average, since PCC began partnering with local schools.
- Witnessed abortion decreasing by more than 53% in the past 9 years.
- Ensured healthy birth-weight babies through our Nutrition Education Program. In nine years, 100% of participating clients have avoided low birth-weight babies and pre-term birth.
