Last year, 2,752 pregnancy help organizations provided nearly 2 million people with free services, saving communities at least \$161 million. That's more than 5,000 people a day, saving taxpaying citizens more than \$440,000—every day.

More than **7 in 10 pregnancy help organizations now provide ultrasounds, 1,944 in all.** This is a 24% increase from 2010.

Pregnancy help medical clinics provided **400,100 ultrasounds in 2017**; this is more than 1,000 per day.

100 Mobile units with ultrasound are now on the road, bringing services to women in their communities.

Heartbeat International's OptionLine receives **30,000 contacts each month** through its telephone hotline and email/ chat lines, reaching women and men facing the challenge of an unexpected pregnancy.

67,400 volunteers serve pregnancy centers, including an estimated **7,500 medical professionals** giving their time and skills.

Pregnancy help organizations provided **679,600 free pregnancy tests** in 2017, saving their clients an estimate \$6.1 million.
