

A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Standing Strong: Defending Hope from Coast to Coast

This year began with an unexpected legal battle when the Attorney General of California sued Heartbeat International and an affiliate for promoting Abortion Pill Reversal (APR). The first word came not from the state but from a reporter alerting us to the lawsuit—proof that abortion-friendly media were informed before we were. Yet, even as AG Bonta attempted to silence our work, his public statements brought three times as many women to our Abortion Pill Rescue Network (APRN), seeking to reverse their chemical abortions.

The attacks didn't stop there. Soon, New York's Attorney General followed suit, targeting Heartbeat and eleven pregnancy help organizations for offering women a second chance at choice. In the span of months, we found ourselves defending APR from coast to coast.

Whether it's in the courtroom or the counseling room, we will stand for life. That means standing for her against powerful political forces arrayed against her, by attacking us.

It is the pregnancy help movement that has stood the strongest against abortion even as the United States was plunged into the darkness of the *Roe v. Wade* decision. **Pregnancy help outreach was successful when the laws weren't,** rescuing hundreds of thousands of lives each year. Now in the post-Roe era, the abortion industry is sparing no expense to align its politicians against us.

Fortunately, we have the truth on our side. The truth is that progesterone can offer the chance to reverse the effects of the abortion pill. The truth is that women don't really want an abortion and will change their trajectory when lovingly offered alternatives.

Even in a year of major attack, **Heartbeat International reached a record high** number of affiliated locations.

Pregnancy help remains a vital outreach for those facing unintended pregnancies. Whether living in or near an abortion state, or able to access the abortion pill online while in a life state, women desperately need an alternative to abortion. That's what pregnancy help is all about. Our need is to bring hope and help to her quicker, ever-increasing our speed to care. In doing so, we'll increase our speed to success, successfully helping her choose life.







RESCUED THROUGH THE ABORTION PILL RESCUE NETWORK

Elizabeth & Ben's Story

In the face of an unexpected pregnancy, Elizabeth found herself alone and uncertain. A brief reunion with her ex-partner, Ben, had resulted in a positive pregnancy test, but with Ben already moved out and doubts from family and friends clouding her excitement, she struggled to see a way forward.

Desperate for guidance, Elizabeth turned to Planned Parenthood, where she felt pressured into taking the first abortion pill. Almost immediately, regret set in—especially after receiving a text from Ben expressing his desire to keep their baby. Searching frantically for hope, she discovered Abortion Pill Reversal (APR) and reached out for help.

Thanks to the support of the Abortion Pill Rescue® Network and a caring pregnancy help community, Elizabeth began the journey of reversing the abortion. With each passing week, as she saw her baby growing through sonograms at her local pregnancy center, her confidence and hope were restored.

On January 18, 2024, Elizabeth gave birth to Evelyn, a beautiful testament to life, love, and second chances. Parenthood brought Elizabeth and Ben back together—strengthening their bond and reaffirming the importance of APR for women in crisis. Now engaged, they are planning a future as a family, with a wedding in the works.

Elizabeth and Ben's journey didn't stop there. They took Evelyn to Washington, D.C. on the anniversary of Elizabeth taking the abortion pill to share their story with lawmakers, advocating for a woman's right to information about APR. As residents of California—a state actively trying to silence pregnancy centers and Heartbeat International—their voices carried a powerful message: Women deserve real choices and real support.

Elizabeth's story is just one example of how Heartbeat International and the pregnancy help movement empower women with hope and life-affirming options. Through APR, pregnancy centers, and unwavering compassion, lives are being saved, and families are being strengthened every day.




REACH WOMEN, SAVE GENERATIONS

Option Line® is our pregnancy help contact center, available 24/7 for anyone reaching out for help.

Conveniently accessible, Option Line offers compassionate, personalized guidance for all who reach out.

Since answering the first call in 2003, we've reached more than 7 million women and men, many who are desperate for answers in an unexpected pregnancy.

This year, Option Line experienced a record-breaking surge in outreach, receiving more than 312,000 phone calls—a 5.5% increase over last year. Through calls alone, Option Line connected almost a quarter million people to pregnancy help. These calls, in addition to countless connections made via chat, text, and email, reflect **a growing need for immediate and personal guidance.** Whether in the middle of the night or during a crisis moment, our trained consultants offer hope, support, and a link to local pregnancy help organizations equipped to walk alongside women in their journeys.



LACY'S BATTLE FOR TRUTH

CALLS INTO OPTION LINE

Lacy, just 16, reached out to Option Line after a teacher discouraged her from visiting a local pregnancy help center, claiming it was "not even a real medical center." **The teacher even scheduled Lacy an appointment at an abortion clinic**, pressuring her by saying she is "too smart" to have a baby at this time of her life.

Feeling pressured and uncertain, Lacy turned to Option Line. Our consultant listened, reassured her, and helped her process her options without coercion. Most importantly, we encouraged her to trust her instincts. Before making any final decisions, Lacy agreed to visit a local pregnancy help center—one that Option Line offered to schedule for her.

Lacy's story is just one of hundreds of thousands that underscore Option Line's vital, life-changing work.

Offering Hope & Help When Parents Need It Most

PrenatalDiagnosis.org: The first of its kind, this groundbreaking website provides families facing a difficult prenatal diagnosis with access to specialized, trauma-informed Parent Care Coordinators through Option Line, a program of Heartbeat International. As the first point of contact, Option Line is dedicated to answering these calls and connecting parents to life-affirming help. These Parent Care Coordinators offer free, compassionate guidance, ensuring parents receive the information and support they need to navigate their journey with confidence and care.

While parents who want children may be thrown into the abortion discussion if their child receives a negative prenatal diagnosis—often by medical professionals—having life-affirming supporters and resources available during this delicate time is essential. **PrenatalDiagnosis.org ensures that no parent has to face this journey alone, offering hope, clarity, and unwavering support.**

What is Option Line Plus?

For the average pregnancy help center, 24/7 availability is impractical, and in many cases impossible. During critical hours when most pregnancy help centers are not open, Option Line consultants can now schedule clients for a one-time educational call with a nurse. These calls are

typically scheduled within 2 hours of the client's initial contact, and scheduled calls have an astounding show rate of more than 90%.

During their interaction with an Option Line Plus consultant, a client will receive valuable education, better understand the value of visiting a pregnancy help organization, and finally, will be referred to or scheduled for an appointment at their local center. When nurses are not on calls, they also answer chats, emails, and text messages.

THE IMPACT OF THE ABORTION PILL RESCUE NETWORK

A Lifeline of Hope


In 2024, the Abortion Pill Rescue Network (APRN) continued its life-saving mission, offering second chances to women who regret taking the first dose of a chemical abortion. With over 1,000 healthcare prescribers—alongside clinics, hospitals, and pharmacies—APRN's reach has nearly doubled since Heartbeat International acquired it in 2018, with a record number of reversal starts occurring in the month of December. The network has assisted women in all 50 U.S. states and 96 countries, ensuring that no woman is left without hope.

This year alone, we shared the message of Abortion Pill Reversal (APR) in more than 20 live events and numerous virtual sessions. Most importantly, 92% of women who spoke with our nurses in the last year began the reversal protocol, choosing life for their babies. Each of these lives saved is a testament to the power of compassion, timely care, and the unwavering belief that it's never too late to choose life—and by equipping others through trainings and virtual events, we're helping even more women discover that same hope.

A SAFE HOME

Strengthening the Maternity Housing Movement

In 2024, the Maternity Housing Coalition witnessed a year of inspiring growth, reflecting a rising tide of support for expectant and new mothers across the United States and beyond. Nationally, maternity homes neared 500—an uptick driven partly by the post-*Dobbs* landscape, with a 17% increase since 2022 and new startups doubling from the prior year. The Coalition's affiliates—the heart of this movement—reached 198, growing by nearly 14%, with a striking 38.5% rise since *Dobbs*. The Coalition now spans 48 states and serves over 1,200 women each year by conservative estimates. These homes, often linked with pregnancy help centers, weave a vital safety net, adapting to meet a growing need with compassion and resolve.

Globally, the story expands further, with over 150 maternity homes operating now in 30 countries. International affiliates, exceeding 70, helped boost the Coalition's global market share by 17%, outpacing the U.S.'s more modest 4% rise to 42%. This surge hints at a universal call to action, resonating from small communities to sprawling urban centers. Through networking, training, and advocacy, the Maternity Housing Coalition continues to do more than just equip homes—it builds hope.

In a shifting world, 2024 marks a step closer to ensuring no mother stands alone.

ANAHI & ELIAS

At just 19 years old, Anahi found herself facing an unplanned pregnancy while juggling two jobs and college coursework. Having escaped an abusive home at 17, she had been couch-hopping with no real sense of stability. When she learned she was pregnant, she was sharing a bed with a friend and her dog—far from the secure home she longed to provide for her baby.

Desperate for stability, Anahi turned to her son's father despite their toxic relationship. As the abuse escalated, she felt increasingly trapped. By the time she gave birth, hospital security had to remove him for her safety. Returning to the same cycle of abuse, she feared her son would grow up in the same painful reality she had endured.


Hope arrived when a friend told her about our housing affiliate, Thrive. She applied immediately and found not just shelter but a path to healing and independence. At the maternity home, Anahi gained the support and resources to continue her education, build a stable life, and break free from the cycle of abuse.

Anahi shared her story with lawmakers in June 2024 at our Babies Go to Congress event because no mother should have to choose between a safe home or her child's life. Today, she is thriving—empowered to create a future filled with hope for herself and Elias.

LOVE APPROACH ULTRASOUND CLINIC


Heartbeat International's LOVE Approach Ultrasound Clinical training is equipping nurses and sonographers to save lives in pregnancy help medical clinics nationwide. Since launching in 2021, more than 350 healthcare professionals have completed LOVE Approach Ultrasound Clinical (LAUC) events, while more than 1,000 healthcare professionals have been trained in Heartbeat's Online Ultrasound Training since 2018. Through this comprehensive program, we have trained nurses, sonographers, physicians, midwives, nurse practitioners, and physician assistants to perform limited obstetric diagnostic ultrasounds in pregnancy help medical clinics. Each year, healthcare professionals receive more than 3,200 hours of continuing education through this key training.

INNOVATIVE WAYS TO SAVE LIVES

By combining state-of-the-art simulation technology with expert instruction, we now train more than 100 professionals each year to provide life-affirming imaging that empowers women to choose life. This program ensures trainees receive both excellent technical training and instruction on how to provide compassionate care. Online coursework that meets AWHONN guidelines and requires 25 prerequisite OB scans are followed by hands-on instruction from highly credentialed sonographers and experienced RNs. By integrating technical, practical, and spiritual aspects in our ultrasound training, Heartbeat strives to ensure that every trainee is fully equipped, qualified, and ready to scan within their center, directly impacting lives and helping women choose life for their babies.









UNITED FOR LIFE

Heartbeat International's 53rd Annual Conference, held in Salt Lake City under the theme United for Life, brought together more than 2,000 leaders from across the globe—on-site and online—for our largest gathering ever. With over 130 in-depth and practical sessions, keynote inspiration, and powerful moments of prayer and worship, the conference equipped pregnancy help leaders to stand strong in a rapidly changing landscape. From life-affirming medical professionals to client service directors and housing leaders, participants were trained, refreshed, and united in mission. As opposition mounts, this week reminded us that the global pregnancy help movement is growing, innovating, and deeply committed to offering women hope—and a future full of life.

BETTER TOGETHER: LINKING PREGNANCY CENTERS & CHURCHES

Heartbeat International is proud to partner with Embrace Grace to strengthen the connection between pregnancy help organizations and local churches. This collaboration equips churches to provide spiritual, emotional, and practical support to single and pregnant women through biblically grounded support groups. **Together, we're helping women experience holistic care that extends beyond the pregnancy decision—fostering lasting relationships and faith-filled community through the church.**





MOVING THE MOVEMENT

More Access, More Abortions— Even as Clinics Close

Since 2020, there has been a slow and steady decline in brick-and-mortar abortion facilities. It may appear that abortion access is shrinking, but the full picture reveals a different—and urgent—reality: **abortion access is expanding, and the number of abortions is rising.**

According to Advancing New Standards in Reproductive Health (ANSIRH) at the University of Californiaⁱ, there were 758 brick-and-mortar abortion facilities in the U.S. in 2020, and that decreased to 741 in 2023. However, by 2023, **226 new virtual abortion clinics had opened.**

That makes 967 total places women could access abortion in 2023—more than any point in the past decade.



Meanwhile:

- Abortions rose from 930,160 in 2020 to over 1 million in 2023
- Reported telehealth abortions accounted for 20% of all U.S. abortions by mid-2024
- Planned Parenthood continues to hold a 40% market share
- Mail-order pill websites like Plan C and Aid Access make it increasingly difficult to track abortion numbers accurately as they are not required to report

WHAT'S DRIVING THIS INCREASE?

- Rapid expansion of telehealth and mail-order abortions
- New clinics in permissive states
- Interstate travel assistance from pro-abortion groups

WHY THIS MATTERS FOR PREGNANCY HELP

While the abortion industry adapts and expands into digital spaces, pregnancy help organizations are rising to meet the challenge.

It's more important than ever for centers to implement telecare, either by partnering with Option Line or offering it through their own teams.


Heartbeat International has been leading the way, equipping and empowering pregnancy help organizations to embrace this new era and meet today's woman right where she is—online, on her phone, and in need of real help.

And affiliates are responding!

Since last year, there has been a 172% increase in pregnancy help organizations offering telehealth—growing from 46 to 125 in just one year.

Abortion clinics may be decreasing, but abortions are not.

The battleground has shifted—and so must we. Through innovation, connection, and compassionate care, the pregnancy help movement is not only keeping pace, but moving forward.





Sources of Income*


October 1, 2023 - September 30, 2024
